

FOUNDING MEMBER PROGRAM 2011-12

FULL MEMBERS

Full members in the WNYAPCC must be long-term care, assisted living and/or health services providers, educators, associations, or ancillary service providers in Western New York. There are both organizational and individual members. Membership benefits are the same for each category. Organizational members will be represented by their CEOs, Administrators of Record (AOR) or designees of either.

Benefits of full membership include:

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

This is a non-voting category of WNYAPCC membership for individuals and organizations that wish to support the purposes of the Alliance and stay up-to-date on person-centered care/culture change initiatives and all the Alliance activities. Organizational associate membership is available only to organizations that do not provide long-term care, assisted living or health services.

Benefits of associate membership include:

- Discounted participation in person-centered care grant-funded trainings and initiatives
